Bill Robe called to order at 4:02 p.m.

Open Item Discussion and Updates:

Public Access to common areas

Additional information under review with Chief Morris.

D&O Insurance

• Discussed at the Insurance Review with Alliance agency, SA will not provide D&O insurance for HAC or its committees.

Wells Fargo Reserve Investment

- Tom/HAC requested that the funds be FDIC insured and Interest bearing
- SA staff is working with Chancellors Office to determine what investment instruments are available for UGlen Reserve funds.

Legal Response to HAC request for governmental jurisdictions applicable to UGlen.

No updates from SA legal counsel and does not fall under the CAG's purview.

CAG Reorganization

- Tom mentioned the HAC provided a response to the SA's CAG reorganization draft. It is now up to SA to review and comment.
- Laurie appreciated the HAC comments and reiterated that the CAG serves the purpose of a meeting amongst all groups to have an open communication and address Uglen community issues not resolved by UGCAM/HAC/Subcommittees.
 - o Laurie's intent is to move forward with a working document that insures the intended purpose of the CAG
- Tom mentioned that clarification is needed between what issues to bring to the CAG and the BAG.
- SA responded that unresolved community issues would be brought to the CAG, BAG addresses budget and financial issues.

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HAC Report: (by T. Bokhart)

Rules and Regulations document sent earlier

- o HAC rewrote the entire addendum as a draft.
- o HAC requested discussion as to whether the draft raises any "red flag" concerns of SA before sharing with residents for comments.
 - HAC proposes to gain consensus through sending out a draft copy, posting somewhere accessible to residents and requesting feedback. Possible townhall meeting for purpose of compiling comments and determining resident support.
 - Results of community response to be shared at CAG meeting.
- o Laurie mentioned the final decision will be made by SA.
- o Laurie doesn't object to sharing with the community but requested time for more thorough review.
- o Laurie complimented the effort made to create the detailed rules and regulations draft.
 - Community feedback will bring forward ideas and how it effects the community
 - Pragmatic approach to implementation was discussed.
 - New draft expands and sometimes modifies existing R&Rs
 - The community input and validation of the revised R&Rs will provide support and transparency.
 - Jake mentioned that KW and SA will need to have further conversation regarding implementation and enforcement.
 - Enforcement expectations to be clarified.
 - Police response to be clarified
 - Fines for violations have not changed but enforcement needs further clarification.
- o Ben Gordon (KW) mentioned he didn't see any conflict and commented that, in most cases, apartment rules are more stringent.
- Tom mentioned draft included requirement for binding arbitration if issues arise that cannot be resolved through existing procedures.
 - o It was suggested that mediation be substituted for binding arbitration which is what is covered by budget item.
- Ben Gordon asked to have the Apartments isolated from the cost of arbitration and mediation
 as the disputes over R&Rs would apply only to townhomes and single family homes. KW should
 not participate in costs of owner and SA disputes.
 - o Laurie confirmed the budgeted line item was specific to mediation and not arbitration.
- HAC is requesting comments from SA before submitting to residents.
 - o Time frame for a response from the SA by May 10th
 - o HAC is only concerned with any issues in the draft that would be "red flags" or "deal breakers" for the SA before submitting for resident comments.
- CSUCI Campus Police part of the enforcement for the R&R's
 - o HAC expects safety on street will be jurisdiction of the police to enforce
 - Example: Helmet safety to be enforced at the discretion of the campus police

Item brought forward regarding the HAC Committees

- Laurie asked for reference to "policy" be changed to "advisory" as more accurate to the role of committees.
- HAC requests input from SA for the following: Should committee chairman be HAC member or
 just a member of the committee; guidelines for how HAC supervises the subcommittees; should
 non-HAC members be allowed on committees; structure of committees and oversight.
- It was determined these above issues should be discussed amongst HAC members before requesting a response from the SA.
- Laurie mentioned she would review with the operations team but unable to respond at this time.

E&S Ring (by Ben Gordon)

UGCAM Report: (by Jake Friesen)

- Ventura County is moving into the (COVID) Orange Tier
 - o Opening Gyms and scheduling use of the gyms
 - o The pool monitor is still applicable
 - Yellow Tier possibly in a week. Not yet determined how much longer the pool monitor will be required.
- Landscape Phase I authorized to move forward by FY '20/'21
 - o \$162k is the budgetary amount for this phase.
 - o Includes Anacapa, Landing Cove, and four roundabouts
 - o Phase 2 to follow next year.
- Brush Clearance is being addressed with Brightview to meet June 1 requirement per State law
- Sidewalk trip hazards completed by the end of fiscal year within \$20k budget

Site Authority: (By L. Nichols)

- SA Budget Review under executive leadership
- Significant changes for the Fall
 - o Required vaccinations for all Staff and Students
 - o More information to come
- Campus to be fully repopulated by Fall (2021)
 - o Not 6,000 students all in one day
 - Phased to bring back the staff/faculty
- As an employer CSU is required to mandate requirements per CAL OSHA
 - o Maintain 6 ft distancing, masks, etc.
 - o Hopefully to receive revised guidelines to address the "CLOSED Campus" Status
 - o Rosa reported an Increase in home sales.
