- Start preparing for the possibility of an evacuation
- Stand up EOC
- Coordinate necessary resources



Communication

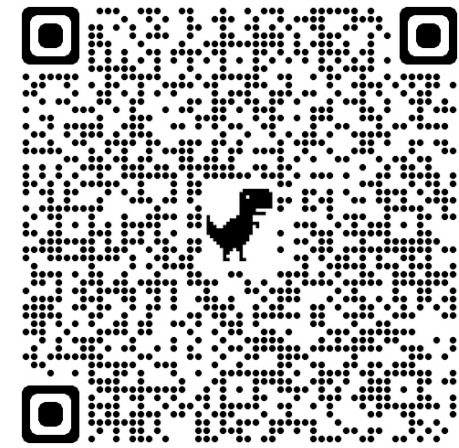
- Start community notifications through CSUCI Alert
- Connect with UGCAM and Mission Hills offices



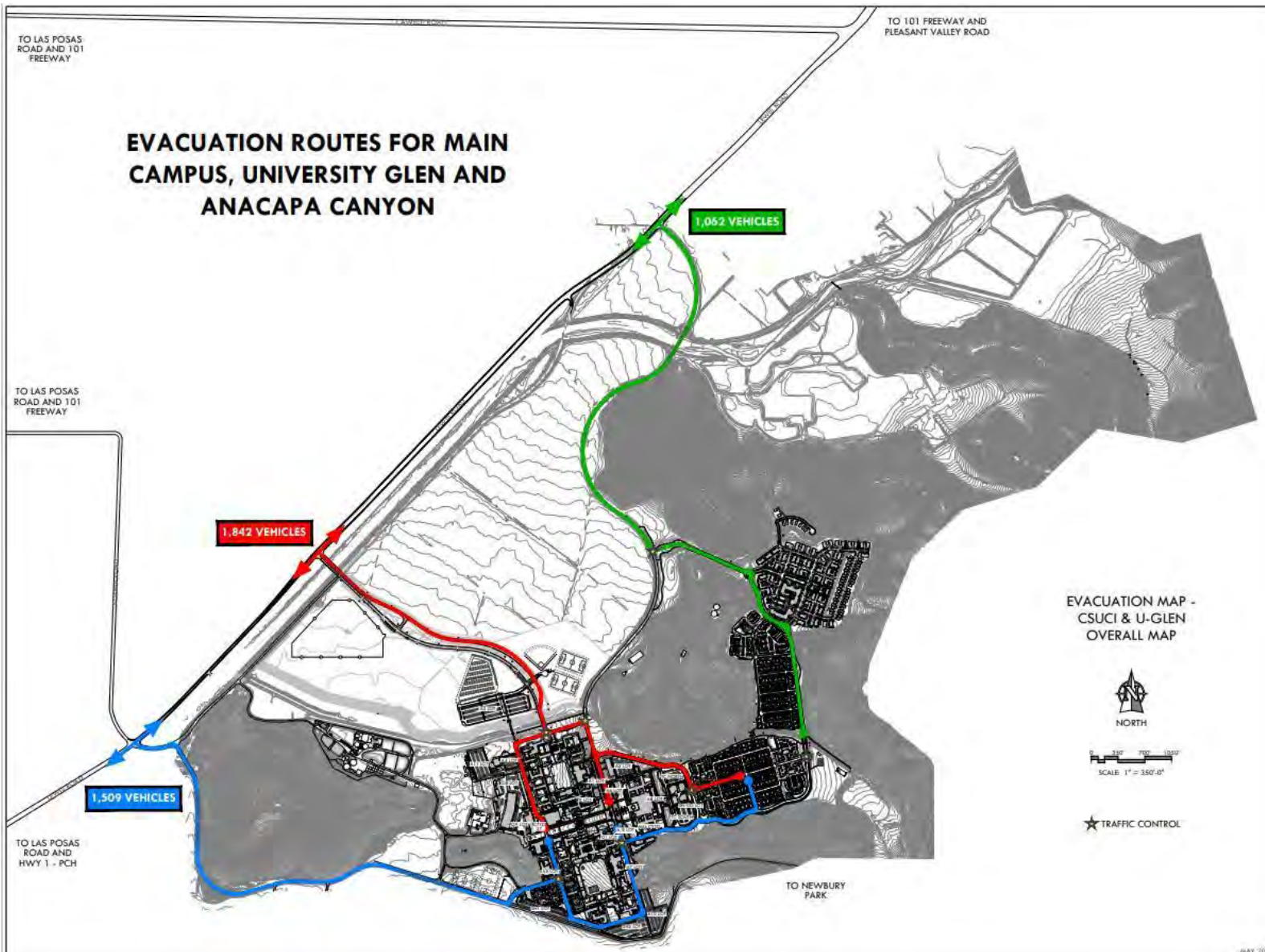
Evacuation Protocol

- Notification of evacuation
- Request additional resources
- Controls for outbound traffic only
- Deploy evacuation teams into the community

<p>Follow Public Safety instructions for guided escorts.</p>	<p>Contact Public Safety if assistance is needed.</p>

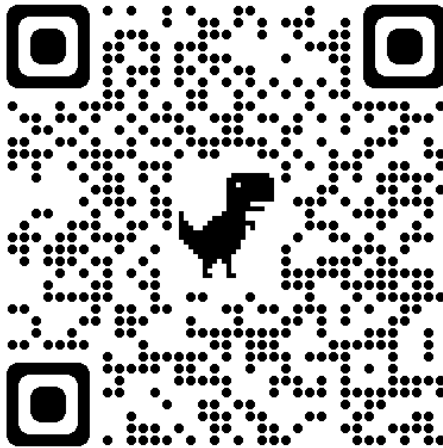

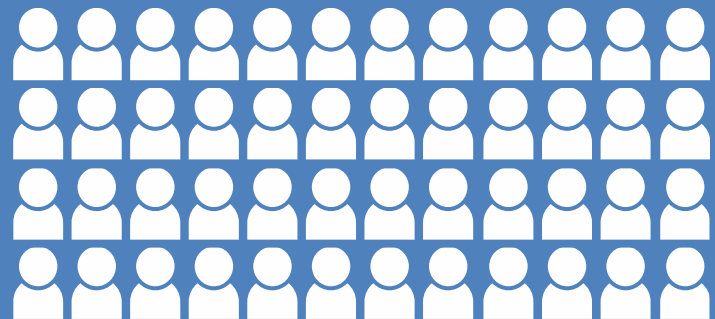
